Transfer Credit Schedule 2011/2012

The CGA association evaluates post-secondary courses for transfer credit in the CGA program. The Transfer Credit Schedule is prepared for information and guidance only. As course numbers and content change depending on the year of study, this schedule is subject to change without notice.

Transfer credits granted will be based on the Association's evaluation of the students' academic credentials. Students may apply for advanced standing by forwarding a completed Application for Advanced Standing to the CGA Student Services office, along with official transcripts and a resume of any related experience. Where multiple university/college courses are listed for a CGA credit, all the courses must be completed. A minimum course grade of C+ is normally required for transfer credit, unless otherwise stated.

Accordingly, a MPAcc degree holder may only require the CGA PA1 and PA2 course/exam requirements to satisfy CGA's educational standard for professional certification. For courses completed in 2008/2009 and subsequent years.

** Transfer credit for BC1 will be granted in cases where the applicant has completed the noted course and a college business diploma or a university business degree with transfer credits in FA1, FA2, FA3, CM1, MA1, MS1 and FN1. Credit in these courses alone is not sufficient for transfer credit in BC1.
