

# Selection Criteria and Procedures for Applications

## GENERAL CRITERIA FOR ALL SCHOLARSHIPS AND BURSARIES

1. The applicants must be intending to register or already be registered students in the CGA Program of Professional Studies in Saskatchewan.
2. The scholarships must be applied to tuition. If the recipient has already paid in full, a cheque will be issued to the student; otherwise the cheque will be issued to the Association. Awards and bursaries will be issued either to the student or the Association at the discretion of the CGA Saskatchewan Scholarship Fund Inc. board of directors.
3. The main criteria for selection will be academic achievement. Preference may be given to eligible applicants demonstrating financial need.
4. Completed applications must be submitted by the due dates indicated, in each year, to be eligible for annual scholarships, awards and bursaries. Announcements of and presentations to successful applicants will be made at the next post-secondary institution award ceremonies and/or the annual CGA Saskatchewan fall conference.

## **SPECIFIC CRITERIA FOR CGA SCHOLARSHIPS AND BURSARIES**

**(Deadline for applications August 15<sup>th</sup>)**

### **Debbi Dillon Memorial Fund - \$800.00**

The applicant must:

1. Be completing first level in the current academic year.
2. Have an average grade in the top 20% of all students' grades in all courses in first level. All three courses must have been completed through the CGA program. All three courses need not have been completed in one year.

### **Past Presidents' Fund - \$800.00**

The applicant must:

1. Be a resident of the province of Saskatchewan.
2. Be enrolled at the 4<sup>th</sup> level or higher of the CGA program. The student must have a minimum of 3 courses left to complete.
3. Have an average grade in the top 20% of all students' grades for the last three courses taken.
4. Have demonstrated leadership (by function or position) within a non-profit or charitable organization in which the student is a volunteer.

### **Howard Janzen Management Accounting Stream Scholarship - \$800.00**

The applicant must:

1. Have completed QU1, MA1 and MA2. The highest average grade achieved over these three courses will be used for selecting the recipient. Applicants must have passed at least 2 of these 3 courses through CGA to be considered. Preference will be given to those students who have completed all three courses through CGA. The last of these courses must have been completed in the current academic year.
2. Have a minimum of three courses left to complete.

### **General Fund Financial Accounting Stream Scholarship - \$800.00**

The applicant must:

1. Have completed FA1, FA2 and FA3. The highest average grade achieved over these three courses will be used for selecting the recipient. Applicants with an exemption for FA1 may be considered. The last of these courses must have been completed in the current academic year.
2. Have a minimum of three courses left to complete.

### **KGR Memorial Scholarship - \$600.00**

The applicant must:

1. Be a resident of the province of Saskatchewan
2. Be enrolled at the 4<sup>th</sup> level or higher of the CGA Program of Professional Studies.
3. Have demonstrated leadership (by function or position) within a non-profit or charitable organization in which the student is a volunteer.
4. Preference may be given to eligible applicants demonstrating financial need.

**Level 2 Scholarship - \$800.00**

The applicant must:

1. Have completed FA2, QU1 and MA1. The highest average grade achieved over these three courses will be used for selecting the recipient. The last of these courses must have been completed in the current academic year.

**Level 3 Scholarship - \$800.00**

The applicant must:

1. Have completed FA3, FN1 and MS1. The highest average grade achieved over these three courses will be used for selecting the recipient. The last of these courses must have been completed in the current academic year.

**BURSARIES**

**(Deadline for applications August 15<sup>th</sup>)**

**General Fund “Students in Need” Bursaries (two awarded annually) - \$600.00 each**

The applicant must:

1. Be an existing CGA student or is intending to register to enter the CGA Saskatchewan program of studies in the upcoming academic year.

**NOTE:** Selection criteria are subject to change at the discretion of the directors of the scholarship fund.

**SPECIFIC CRITERIA FOR POST-SECONDARY SCHOLARSHIPS**

**(Deadline for applications February 1<sup>st</sup>)**

**General Fund SIAST Students’ Scholarship (two awarded annually) - \$600.00 each**

The applicant must:

1. Be a current student of this educational institution who has or is intending to register to enter the CGA Saskatchewan program of studies.

**General Fund University of Regina Students’ Scholarship - \$600.00**
